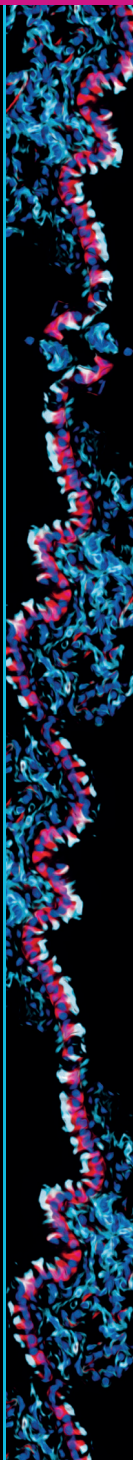

Gute Kommunikationsfähigkeit wird von 90 % der Arbeitgeber als eine wesentliche Schlüsselkompetenz und neben fachlicher Qualifikation als wesentliches Einstellungskriterium angesehen. Bereits im Vorstellungsgespräch oder Assessment-Center werden mit gekonnter Kommunikation die Weichen gestellt. Viele Studierende und BerufseinsteigerInnen fühlen sich bei überzeugender und gleichzeitig wertschätzender Kommunikation auf unsicherem Terrain. Jeder kennt diese Situationen: Man wird mit einer Aussage konfrontiert und findet keine Gegenantwort, man möchte seine Leistung oder Argumente überzeugend darlegen und hat das Gefühl, dass beim Gegenüber etwas anderes ankommt. Ziel ist es, das Gesagte so zu formulieren, dass der Andere es versteht und man überzeugt. Um das Gesagte zu unterstreichen und diesem somit mehr Ausdruck zu verleihen ist die nonverbale Kommunikation ebenso bedeutend wie die verbalen Kommunikationstechniken. Neben den passenden und gekonnten Formulierungen geht es um Tonfall, Blickkontakte, Körperspannung, Gestik & Mimik.
